Aiming to create new cultural opportunities for both primary and secondary pupils, the programme is providing a fantastic range of workshops including:

- Musicians visiting schools
- Rehearsal visits – a chance to visit Philharmonic Hall and hear the Royal Liverpool Philharmonic Orchestra in rehearsal
- Ensemble Performances – a wonderful opportunity for pupils to develop their listening skills and experience live music at the highest level
- Instrumental coaching for school orchestras or bands
- Gospel Choir coaching
- A CD Creation Project where young people are introduced to the process of creating a CD from song writing and production to launching and promotion. This project is now well underway with St Austin's, Queens Park, St Mary's & St Thomas, St Anne's and Allanson Street Primary Schools working together to provide a combined CD.

Partnership work continues to be a real strength of the work of the Education Action Zones providing a host of opportunities for children and young people to learn. The aim is not only to provide a rich resource for the coming year but also to explore the means by which they can become a permanent feature of work in all our schools.
